Words to Know

instruction – telling the things that someone should do

raised – to be brought back to life

clearly – easy to understand

baptize – to put a new believer under water for a few seconds and then raise him up out of the water. This is a picture of dying to an old life of sin and being raised to a new life in Christ, and shows the person wants to follow Jesus.

Heaven – the name of the place where God lives
